Herewith, we would like to invite you to the National Freeski Judges Clinic 2024 on the 29th and 30th of November in Innsbruck.

The Judges Clinic is teaching relevant information on how Freeski competitions are being judged. This can be interesting not only for future judges, but also for Freeski coaches, athletes or parents who want to get a better understanding of the sport for their respective backgrounds. Therefore, this clinic has multiple goals for a wide range of participants:

- Participants who successfully pass the exam at the end of the clinic will receive a FIS C-License, which allows them to Judge national FIS events and completes the first level of the FIS judges education path.
- Coaches can gain a better understanding of how their athletes' performance is being judged in competitions and can use this information for their training approach.
- Parents and other Freeski affiliated people can get a very good understanding on how judging is being carried out in Freesking.

There are no prerequisites to participate at this clinic. However, it is recommended that those who want to engage as a judge have a good understanding of the Freeski sport in general.
