Unfortunately, the financial possibilities of the club or the parents were not given, so it was not possible to continue. Racing and skiing was pushed back by apprenticeship, job, starting a family, house building and he became experienced again in the mid-thirties.

Paul then started to participate the Tirol Cup races, the biggest success in the Tirol Cup was certainly in 2006, when he won the overall ranking at the age of 49!!

1996 he started to compete in the Masters Worldcup. Paul won countless races, e.g. 28 Gold metals at World Championships. He is definitely one of the very best Masters racers worldwide.

Paul is not only a great skier. He is a great personality, thoughtful, honest and open minded. This makes him an ideal for many other Masters skiers, but also for youth and children.
